R-Teams (Real-time Event and Auction Management System) was invented because the KidZone Museum was having a hard time checking in and out the guests in a timely manor, managing and accounting for auction items (silent and live), and accounting for bar, raffle, and buy-in sales for their Texas Hold'em fundraising event. They did not know what area made the most money and sometimes did not even know who bought various auction items! R-TEAMS provided an efficient system to simplify the entire event process and provide accurate accounting.

Here is an overview of how it works:

1. Check in

Guests are given barcoded wristbands and self-register / check-in using touch-screen computer stations. Then the guests are off to enjoy the night!

2. Buying, Buying, Buying

Guests buy drinks, raffle tickets, poker chips, auction bids, etc, using their barcoded wristband.

3. Auction Management

Tracking and accounting of live and silent auction item sales are processed electronically right at the bidding tables or live auction area. There is no longer a need to take duplicates of the bid sheet back to a workspace and tabulate who won what, sort it and figure it out. The system will do all of this right away.

4. Check Out

Guests' self-checkout using the touch-screen computer stations. They settle their account paying cash, check, or credit card, and then pickup any won auction items. Thanks for coming!

5. Credit card on file (CCoF) Option

Our system will accept the guest's credit card as they check-in to the event. The CCoF option guarantees payment for all purchases made by the guest.

What we bring: all your systems needs - equipment and software.

What you bring: Volunteer staff. We will go over how many volunteers you need for the amount of guest you are expecting.

Why is it great customer service for our guests?

- The best part of this system is that your guest does not need to look for money during the event. They don't need to be digging into their pockets or purses to find cash or constantly pull out their credit card to make a purchase. They simply use their wristband to make purchases.
- For events such as poker tournaments, where it is inconvenient or impossible for the guest to leave their table to buy drinks or poker chips, your staff goes to the guest to sell them more drinks and poker chips - with the guest using their wristband to make the purchase.
- If your event is hosting the bar, the guests love the ability to just scan their wristbands to pay for their drinks.
- The system makes it easy for the guest to make purchases!

Why is it great for my organization?

- Increased revenue because you made it easy for the guest to make purchases. At the end of the evening, you know how much money you made in each area of sales, and the total income.
- The manual tallying of silent auction bid sheets is completely eliminated - it is all done by the system. Furthermore, a list of auction winners is available as each table closes. The auction management nightmare is over.
- Because our system uses electronic credit card swipe readers, we get great rates on credit card fees. This saves you money! At the end of the event, all you need to do is count the cash.
